Synopsis:

Monday: A weak westerly flow aloft gives marginal instability. With lighter winds, venting expected to be fair.

Tuesday: A weak ridge lingers in the region, with little change to instability. With light winds, venting expected to remain fair.

Wednesday: An upper trough moves through the region, pushing instability upward. With increasing winds, venting improves to good.

Comments: We are seeing shifting in timing and track of features, which is affecting instability and more notably winds, particularly direction. While categories are likely settled, expect to see changes around winds with caution advised if there is any sensitivity to this.
