With respect to areas identified as a potential burial site, BC Hydro does not have information on how deep those potential burials could be. To date, with respect to areas identified as potential burial sites, Aboriginal groups have asked that the sites not be physically disturbed. BC Hydro therefore is unable to confirm whether or not the sites are burials. In conjunction with First Nations who are working with BC Hydro, BC Hydro has undertaken other investigation measures that do not involve ground disturbance in order to identify mitigation and special management measures for the sites. That consultation is ongoing.</p>
