Saturday: High pressure builds over northern BC with cooler air aloft providing an increase in instability. With winds becoming light NW venting will be good.
Sunday: High pressure moves south of the region Sunday afternoon and airmass stability increases. Winds shift to southerly with venting deteriorating to fair
Monday: mixed layer deepens and winds become strong Southwest. Venting improves to good.
