Synopsis:

Monday: Another system moves through the region early in the day, bringing better instability again. With moderate winds, venting is expected to be good.

Tuesday: This system departs, allowing instability to fall in its wake. With lighter winds, venting is expected to fall to fair.

Wednesday: The arctic ridge resurges again, bringing more stable conditions. With lighter winds, venting falls to poor.

Comments: No real issues expected here, but test burns suggested as conditions could trend more marginal for tomorrow.
