Re: Update on helicopter logging near Hudson's Hope

Dear Hudson's Hope resident,

We are writing to provide an update on the use of helicopters that's presently taking place near Hudson's Hope.

We understand that the noise from the helicopters is disturbing and we are selecting flight paths to try to minimize proximity to residents. We recognize that given the location of the timber and the landing areas, that our ability to reduce noise is limited. As such, we will be pausing work during the holiday period.

We thought you would like to know that the helicopter logging just upstream of Maurice Creek will be done no later than Saturday, December 18, dependent upon weather conditions.

The use of helicopters should start to move upstream and downstream away from the community as reservoir clearing activities continue in the new year.

Bailey Helicopters' last day of flying for 2021 will be December 23 and they will be resuming work on January 3, 2022.

We will continue to monitor the work being done by the helicopters to ensure the clearing activities are completed in a safe, timely manner and appreciate the patience of the community.
