

## Site C Employment by Month

Since construction started in summer 2015, BC Hydro's Site C Clean Energy Project has created hundreds of jobs for British Columbians. In the coming months and years, thousands of additional jobs will be created as major contracts get underway for main civil works, turbines and generators, transmission and the generating station and spillways.

The table below shows the on-site construction workforce numbers since August 2015. As with any construction project, the number of workers — and the proportion from any particular location — will vary month-to-month and also reflects the seasonal nature of construction work.
