

BC Hydro Trades & Skilled Training Award

The BC Hydro Trades & Skilled Training Award provides up to \$5,000 for tuition and expenses for certain trades-related programs at Northern Lights College. This award focuses on increasing participation in trades training and supports the development of skilled workers in northeast British Columbia.



Criteria

Students must:

- Enroll full-time in an eligible program at Northern Lights College
- Demonstrate financial need
- Demonstrate residency in northeast B.C.
- Demonstrate academic achievement and excellent attendance during the program

50% of the award will be provided after the student has registered and successfully completed the first week of classes. The remaining 50% will be provided mid-way through the program, after the student has demonstrated academic achievement. Additional funding to cover living expenses may be available based on financial need and personal circumstances.

To apply

- Interested students can apply by providing a cover letter that describes education and work experience, financial need, career and educational goals, and any volunteer or community involvement.
